

# “FREE MONEY” FOR YOUR SCHOOL!

Help your school while you shop.

Here are some **easy ways** to help fund programs, equipment, technology needs and supplies for your school without paying anything extra.

**King Soopers** - Campbell's now does their **Labels for Education** electronically. Go to [kingsoopers.com](http://kingsoopers.com) and register your Sooper Card with e-Labels for Education and choose your school. You can even split it between schools. Everything you buy with the labels will be automatically credited to the school, no labels to cut! Labels include Campbell's, Pepperidge Farm, V-8, Swanson, Prego, etc. Friends and relatives who shop at any Kroger owned store can also register their shopping card with your school.

**Target** - the program is called **Take Charge of Education**. Go to [Target.com](http://Target.com) and click on “redcards” at the top of their home page. Here you can apply for a new account or manage your existing account. You can choose a school to receive the percentage listed below. Schools can be changed easily as your children grow.

If you don't want to use a charge card, there's a new option, a **Target Check card**. Look on “redcards” above to find out how to apply. This is a debit card that draws from your existing checking account but offers all the benefits of a REDcard and will allow you to give to your school when you use it. For use at Target only.

Friends and relatives in any town can give to your school by doing the above. Target will give **1%** back to the school when you use your Target Visa Card at Target, Target Charge Card or the Target Check Card. The school gets **1/2 %** when you shop outside of Target with your Target Visa. Please see the website or inquire at customer service for details and limitation.

**Office Depot** - Simply mention you'd like your purchase to count towards “Your School” when you check out. The clerk will enter a code into the register. The school gets **5%** of your total purchase.
